



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Reflexology foot map



MEDICAL ALERT!

CALCIUM CRISIS CAN BE LIFE-THREATENING

I have HypoParathyroidism, a rare endocrine condition. My blood calcium level may be too low (or occasionally too high) Without urgent medical treatment, serum calcium levels which are too low or too high for hypercalcaemic crisis.

- IMMEDIATE calcium blood test (Pre-triage and uncuffed)
- Around 2.20 mmol/L is the goal in hypoparathyroidism
- Patient may be highly symptomatic at calcium levels at extremes of reference normal range. Check serum magnesium
- Consider emergency IV calcium gluconate if symptomatic hypocalcaemia. If calcium elevated, hydrate
- Frequent monitoring of calcium until stable
- Please contact endocrinologist after stabilisation of acute presentation

Calcium-Sensing Receptor (CaSR)

Calcium is essential for life and calcium levels have to be kept within a narrow range. Parathyroid glands release parathyroid hormone (PTH) to regulate calcium levels. PTH acts on the CaSR to stimulate the release of calcium from bone and to increase calcium reabsorption in the kidney.

WHAT IS PRIMARY HYPERPARATHYROIDISM

Primary hyperparathyroidism (PHPT) is a condition where the parathyroid glands produce too much parathyroid hormone (PTH). This causes a range of symptoms and can lead to complications if not treated.
